Here's an update for members, families and carers on how we're responding to government guidance during the Covid 19 pandemic:

Opening hours:

Heathlands is open Monday – Friday 9am – 3pm

We are currently not open on Saturdays.

This position may change at short notice. Heathlands is following government advice on how to manage Covid 19.

Transport:

To minimise exposure to the risk of exposure to the virus, members should not use public transport to get to Heathlands. Our shuttle run between Heathlands and Asda is currently not running.

Lunch and refreshments:

To ease pressure on our staffing, please bring a packed lunch when coming to Heathlands. We'll continue to have hot and cold drinks available throughout the day.

Keeping safe:

The team are doing all they can to support members to rigorously implement the government's guidance on social distancing whilst at Heathlands. Surfaces are being regularly sanitised.

No-one must come on site if they have a cold, dry cough, high temperature or feel unwell and they must follow government advice on self-isolation.

If anyone falls ill while at Heathlands, they must return home as soon as possible and not return until the period of self-isolation is fully completed.
